### Patch Program

Riversdale patches are available in conjunction with all badge and custom programs and can be purchased for \$2 each.



*Riversdale*, a National Historic Landmark sits on just over 7 acres and is home to a Federal-era historic house, open hearth kitchen, interpretive gardens and orchard, and Visitor Center. The site gives Girl Scouts the opportunity to **blast into the past and experience life in early America with games, cooking, interactive tours, and more!** The Federal-era site of George Calvert, a descendant of Maryland’s founder, the First Lord Baltimore, and his Belgian wife, Rosalie Stier Calvert. It served as the home to nine Calvert children, including Charles Benedict, founder of what is now the University of Maryland, College Park.
